The **Paws of Hope Circle** is a special group of loyal supporters who make annual gifts of \$1,000 or more to the Humane Society of Central Oregon. This helps with our mission to enhance the lives of animals and community members and to care for animals who need our help the most.

For less than \$20 per week, you can make a difference in the lives of the 4,000 animals that come through our doors annually.

Annual membership in the HSCO's **Paws of Hope Circle** can:

- Fund the spay and neutering of 15 dogs
- Educate 10 school classrooms on the humane treatment of all animals
- Transfer in 40 dogs from outside the area, giving them a new 'leash' on life
- Supply microchip IDs for one year for 500 adopted animals
- Provide nearly 6 month's worth of cat litter for our cattery

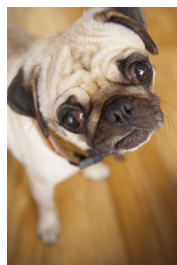
